A December Message from Gohar at UMCOR Armenia Foundation



On behalf of all beneficiaries UMCOR Armenia Foundation wants to say thank you for your kindness and great heart. The deeds are most important factors in our faith as Christians. And you have proved one more time "love your neighbor as yourself".

With donated 3,000 USD, UAF bought 97 pairs of winter shoes and 97 warm jackets for children aged 1 to 15.

Within the framework of this donation, 36 pairs of shoes and 36 jackets were donated to the Jil community (Gegharkunik marz) kindergarten children (to 19 boys and 17 girls). 27 pairs of shoes and jackets were

distributed to children of 11 multimember families, socially vulnerable and malnourished, living in very poor housing conditions (13 boys and 14 girls). The rest was donated to Karinj community, Lori marz.

21 vulnerable children (13 boys and 8 girls) beneficiated in the community kindergarten and 13 children (10 boys and 3 girls) in 6 vulnerable families.

It is difficult to express joy of children and their parents for the gifts. Many children could not attend kindergarten due to lack of shoes and warm clothes. The mothers could hardly help their tears.

God support everyone. Merry Christmas and a very Happy New Year to your community members.
